*Protecting Children by
Strengthening and Preserving
Families*

Mandated Reporting

Requires certain individuals who are acting in a professional or official capacity to immediately report child abuse or neglect.

Applies to children less than 18 years old or if the individual is a physically or mentally impaired person under 21 years of age.

Allow the person who reports the abuse or neglect to follow-up and get certain information after the report is made.



Training Opportunities

Butler County Children Services provides free training for professionals who are mandated to report child abuse and neglect.
